THE FIRST of two secial issues in February will feature Sea Life. The set to be issued on I February (brought forward from the originally announced April date) comprises 10 Ist class stamps printed as a se-tenant block. The stamps depict: Moon Jellyfish, Common Starfish, Sea Anemone, Bass, Thornback Ray, Octopus, Mussels, Grey Seal, Shore Crab, and Common Sun Star. The name of each subject and the year '2007' are positioned on the left side of each stamp.

SEA LIFE ON STAMPS This is the first issue devoted to this topic, but earlier issues are relevant to this theme. The 1988 Linnean Society 18p features a Short-spined Sea scorpion ('Bull-rout'), and a starfish is shown on a 1992 greetings stamp. Marine Life featured on 50p and £1 stamp book covers in 1988-89: Parasitic Anemone on Common Whelk shell and Umbrella Jellyfish; Common Hermit Crab, Bladder Wrack and Laver Spire Shell; and Edible Sea Urchin, Common Starfish and Common Shore Crab •
