




# Incredible objects that have shaped history and culture

The Royal Armouries is the United Kingdom's national museum of arms and armour - and one of the most important institutions of its kind in the world.

The artefacts and stories curated for this set of stamps and souvenirs reflect the international diversity of the Royal Armouries' remarkable collection. It's a treasure trove of more than 75,000 artefacts from around the world, spanning 2.400 years.

Eight new stamps feature images of armour worn by King Henry VIII, King Charles I and other notable historical figures. The Treasures from the Royal Armouries Miniature Sheet showcases stunning pieces assembled over many centuries - from a Ming dynasty sword to an extensively decorated firearm from the 1700s. A fact-filled Presentation Pack and beautifully presented 24-page Prestige Stamp Book reveal insights and images that bring to life objects of arms and armour that have adorned the great palaces, tournament fields and parade grounds of history.


