

So, embark on a voyage of discovery and walk with dinosaurs and other species through a prehistoric world of wonder.



First Class Tyrannosaurus lived during the Late Cretaceous period between 68 and 66 million years ago. The first known specimen was discovered in 1900 in Wyoming, USA.

First Class Triceratops lived around 68 million years ago during the Late Cretaceous period

First Class Coloborhynchus was one of the earliest pterosaurs to be discovered

First Class Iguanodon lived during the Early Cretaceous period between 125 and 110 million years ago £2.00 Stegosaurus is one of the most recognisable dinosaurs, although we know relatively little about it as remains are rare

£2.00 Diplodocus reached up to 27 metres in length and lived 150 million years ago at the end of the Jurassic Period

£2.00 Megalosaurus roamed what is now England between 170 and 155 million years ago

£2.00 Cryptoclidus was a plesiosaur and is described as looking like a 'snake threaded through a turtle'
