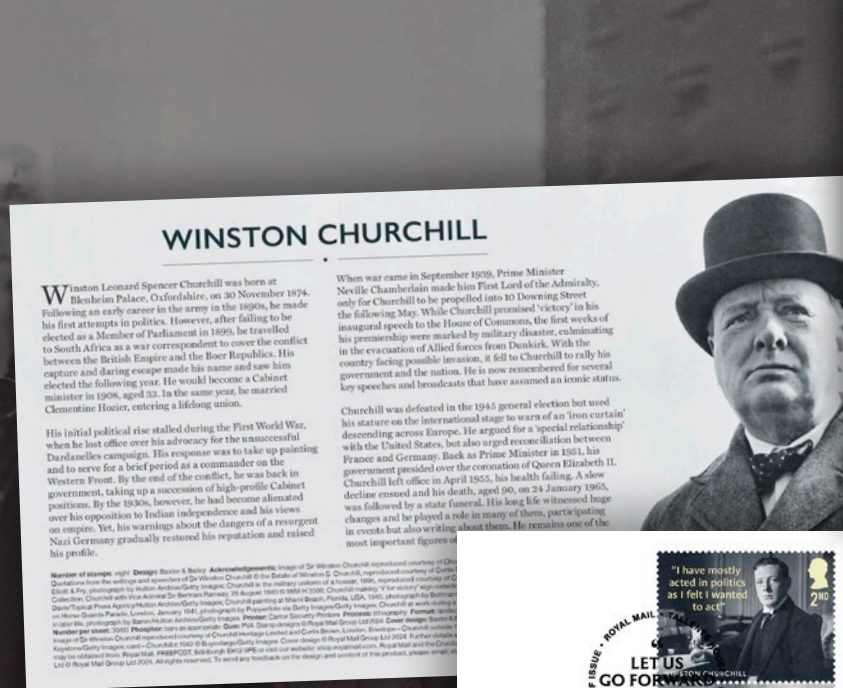

Sir Winston Churchill led our nation through its darkest hours, shaping the course of history and leaving an indelible mark on the hearts of the British people.

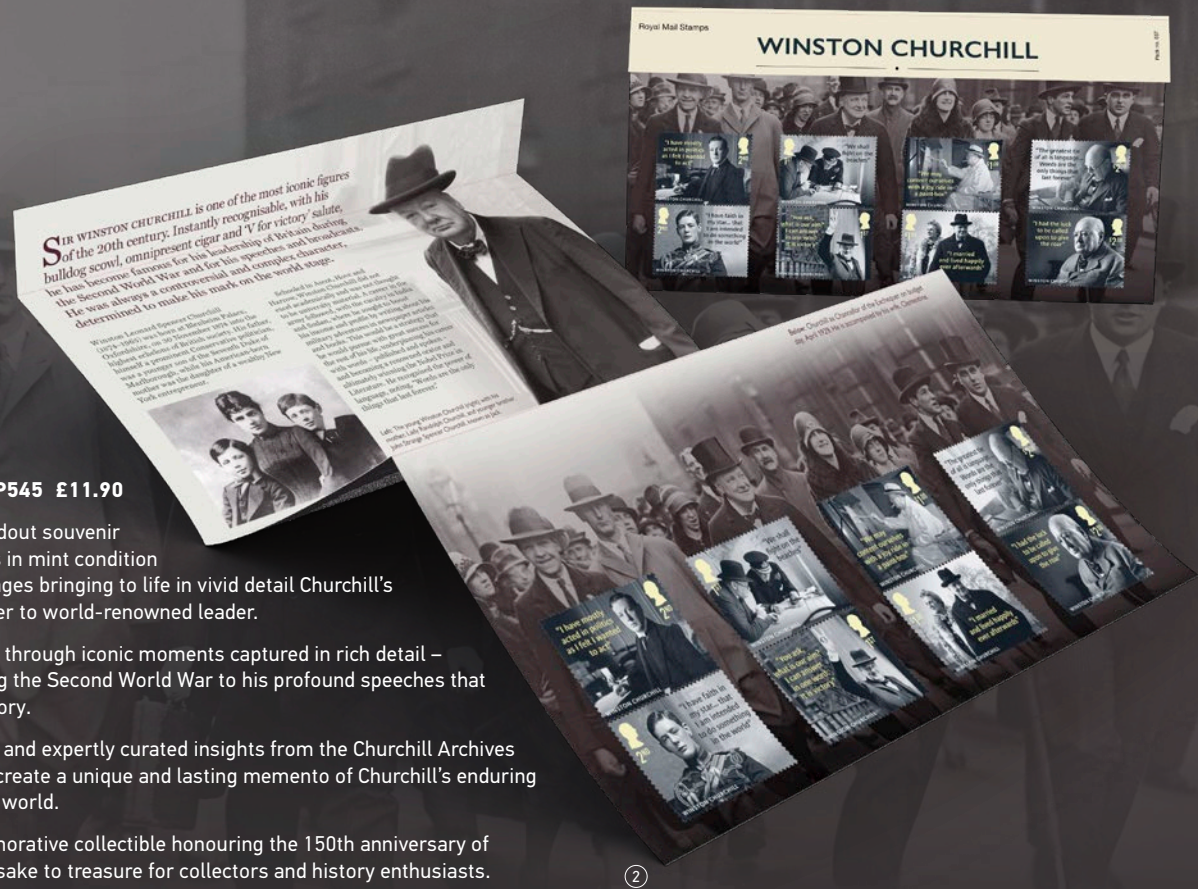

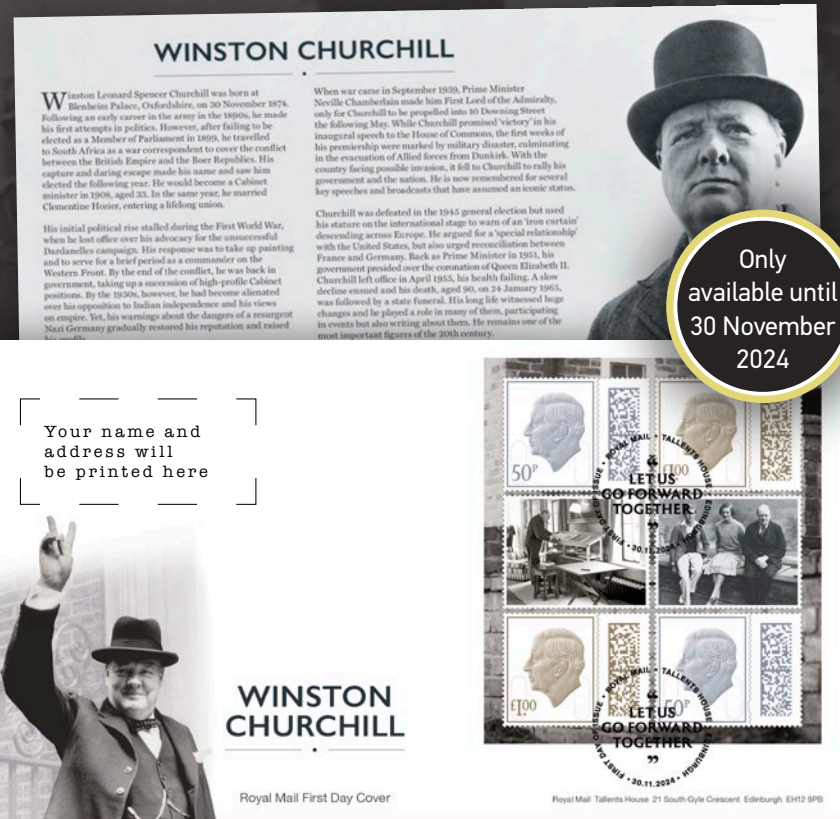
